

Competency Evaluation (Examination)

Temporary Nurse Aides Due to COVID-19

April 13, 2023:

- Based on current advisement from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), all Temporary Nurse Aides (TNA) are required to complete and pass both the written and skills exams by September 10, 2023.
- TNAs will not be allowed to test after September 10, 2023, and will not be refunded for any exam scheduled after September 10, 2023.
- It is advised that all TNAs complete testing as soon as possible.

February 26, 2024:

- Beginning April 1, 2024, the National Council of State Boards of Nursing and Credentia are making changes to the skills component of the Nurse Aide I state-approved Competency Evaluation.
