

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North Carolina Nurse Aide I Registry

<u>Geriatric Aides</u> must be listed on the North Carolina Nurse Aide I Registry prior to being listed on the North Carolina Geriatric Aide Registry.

Training Programs

- Instructors should notify DHSR of the individuals who successfully passed the North Carolina state-approved Geriatric Aide training program to be listed on the North Carolina Geriatric Aide Registry.
- Instructors should include the North Carolina Nurse Aide I Registry listing number of each individual when notifying DHSR.

Expiration Date

There is no expiration date associated with the North Carolina Geriatric Aide Registry.

Renewal Requirements

There are no renewal requirements associated with the North Carolina Geriatric Aide Registry.
