SUBJECT: EXPIRATION of Waiver/Modification of Enforcement of the Training and

Certification of Nurse Aides

TEMPORARY NURSE AIDE NOTICE: Based on current advisement from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), all Temporary Nurse Aides (TNA) are required to complete and pass both the written and skills exams **by September 10**, **2023**. TNAs will not be allowed to test after September 10, 2023, and will not be refunded for any exam scheduled after September 10, 2023. It is advised that all TNAs complete testing as soon as possible.

All nurse aide training emergency waivers for states and facilities will expire on May 11, 2023 consistent with the end of the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE) and the expiration of the CMS waivers. At that time, facilities will have four months (i.e., until September 10, 2023) to have all TNAs who are hired prior to the end of the PHE complete a state-approved NATCEP/CEP. Nurse aides hired after the end of the PHE will have up to four months from their date of hire to complete a state-approved NATCEP/CEP.
